






Yellowstone National Park - A Deeper Look

From nps.gov, "Yellowstone is the only place in the United States where bison have lived continuously since prehistoric times. Yellowstone bison are exceptional because they comprise the nation's largest bison population on public land and are among the few bison herds that have not been hybridized through interbreeding with cattle. Unlike most other herds, this population has thousands of individuals that are allowed to roam relatively freely over the expansive landscape of Yellowstone National Park and some nearby areas of Montana. They also exhibit wild behavior like their ancient ancestors, congregating during the breeding season to compete for mates, as well as migration and exploration that result in the use of new habitat areas. These behaviors have enabled the successful restoration of a population that was on the brink of extinction very recently"







Washington DC Bike Accessibility













Lake County, Florida




Alaska is rich in history and in natural resources.

The ferry system in Washington State is extensive and highly efficient. There are 10 termials just in the Puget Sound area, and about 400 to 500 trips are made each day.









Gentrification Score by Census Tract Atlanta and Eastside Trail, 2000-2018





COVID-19 is an infectious disease which has caused a global pandemic in 2020. So far, the disease has claimed 211,000 lives across the world, and many cases/deaths are still being reported. Major US news outlets often focus on the number of cases and deaths per state, which may not show the entire story.

The objective of this map is to use a more informative approach to visualizing COVID-19 deaths. In this map, fatalities in Georgia are represented in dots and are distributed on a county level. In addition, the deaths per county is compared to the county population to determine the overall rate of death.






"CDC is responding to a pandemic of respiratory disease spreading from person to person caused by a novel (new) coronavirus. Early on, many of the patients at the epicenter of the outbreak in Wuhan, Hubei Province, China had some link to a large seafood and live animal market, suggesting animal-to-person spread. Later, a growing number of patients reportedly did not have exposure to animal markets, indicating person-to-person spread. Person-to-person spread was subsequently reported outside Hubei and in countries outside China, including in the United States. Most international destinations now have ongoing community spread with the virus that causes COVID-19, as does the United States. Community spread means some people have been infected and it is not known how or where they became exposed." - Source: cdc.gov






Percentage of State Populations who Speak a Non-English Language at Home






U.S. Breakdown of Language Groups Spoken at Home








Georgia Public Housing by Congressional District



Grocery Limitations Linked to Obesity











Mining in Western Australia


Western Australia's mining business is thriving with over 100 billion dollars in profits. There are 1,170 mines in western Australia with the highest proportion being located on fault lines for easy access to minerals, metals, and stones. Iron is the most common valuable resource profitting the region of Pilbara with over 63 billion dollars.

Iron is the reason for Pilbara's top status as the most profitable region for mining followed by Goldsfield-Esperance and Perth.



The Kimberley region has the lowest mining profits with the West and East Kimberley making only 289 million combined.









Covid-19 is highly contagious, and CDC advises several practices to protect yourself from contracting the virus and to prevent the spread.

- 5. Clean and disinfect household surfaces often.


Pig Populations Per Capita in New York Counties




Population Growth by State (2000 to 2010)




GDP per Capita by State (2016)





This number indicates the contribution of migration to the overall level of population change. The net migration rate does not distinguish between economic migrants, refugees, and other types of migrants nor does it distinguish between lawful migrants and unlawful migrants. Three countries' migration rates stood out and are explained in more detail near each of those countries.




Malnutrition Rates in African Countries


















Percentage of Foreign-Born Population by U.S. State in 2018

This data, collected by the US Census Bureau in 2018 and released to the public in September 2018, represents the percentage of population who was born outside of the United States, by State.


13.7% of the national population is foreign-born.

Califronia comes out on top with 26.9% of its population foreign-born, and West Virginia has the least with on 1.5% of its population foreign-born.








Education in Rwanda 2010










Homicide Rates by State

The table (right) shows the 10 states with the highest homicide rates in the United States. Mississippi is the state with the highest homicide rate (13.4 deaths per 100,000 people).







Motor Vehicle Occupant Death Rates in the Mountain States





Ohio Drug Related Deaths by Gender








Additional Facts About Suicide in the US

- The age-adjusted suicide rate in 2018 was 14.2 per 100,000 individuals.
 - The rate of suicide is highest in middle-age white men in particular.
- In 2017, men died by suicide 3.54x more often than women.
- On average, there are 129 suicides per day.
- White males accounted for 69.67% of suicide deaths in 2017.
- In 2017, firearms accounted for 50.57% of all suicide deaths.

Tornadoes and Fatalities in the United States

Tornadoes are formed by the collision of warm, humid air and cold, dry air. They can wreak havoc, cause major damage and even loss of life in some cases. The map shows both the number of tornadoes in each state and the rate of fatalities per tornado in 2018. The number of fatalities does not increase linearly with the number of tornadoes.
