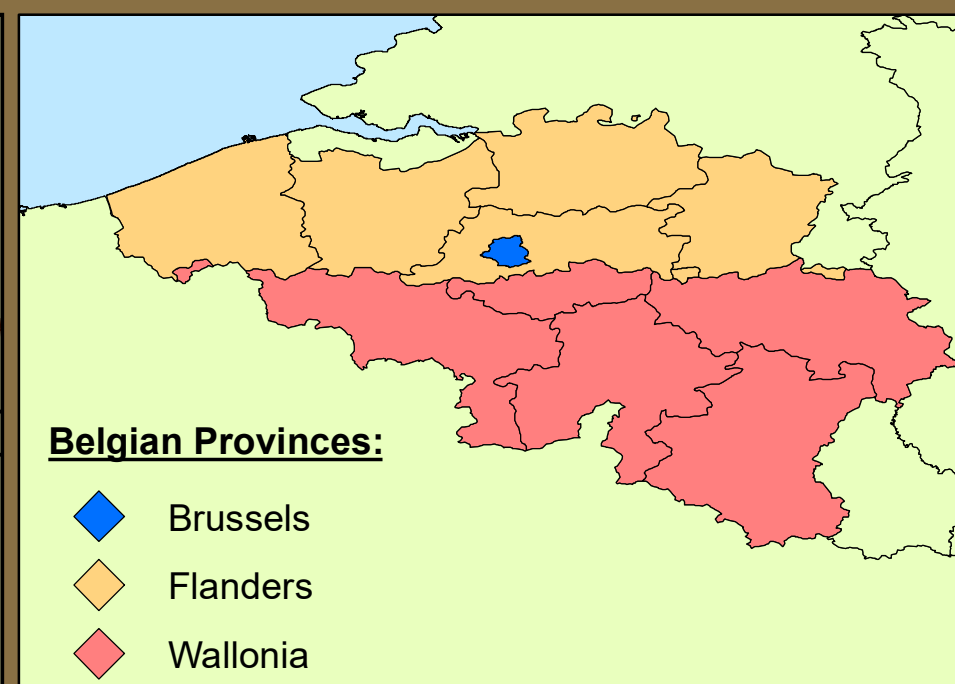
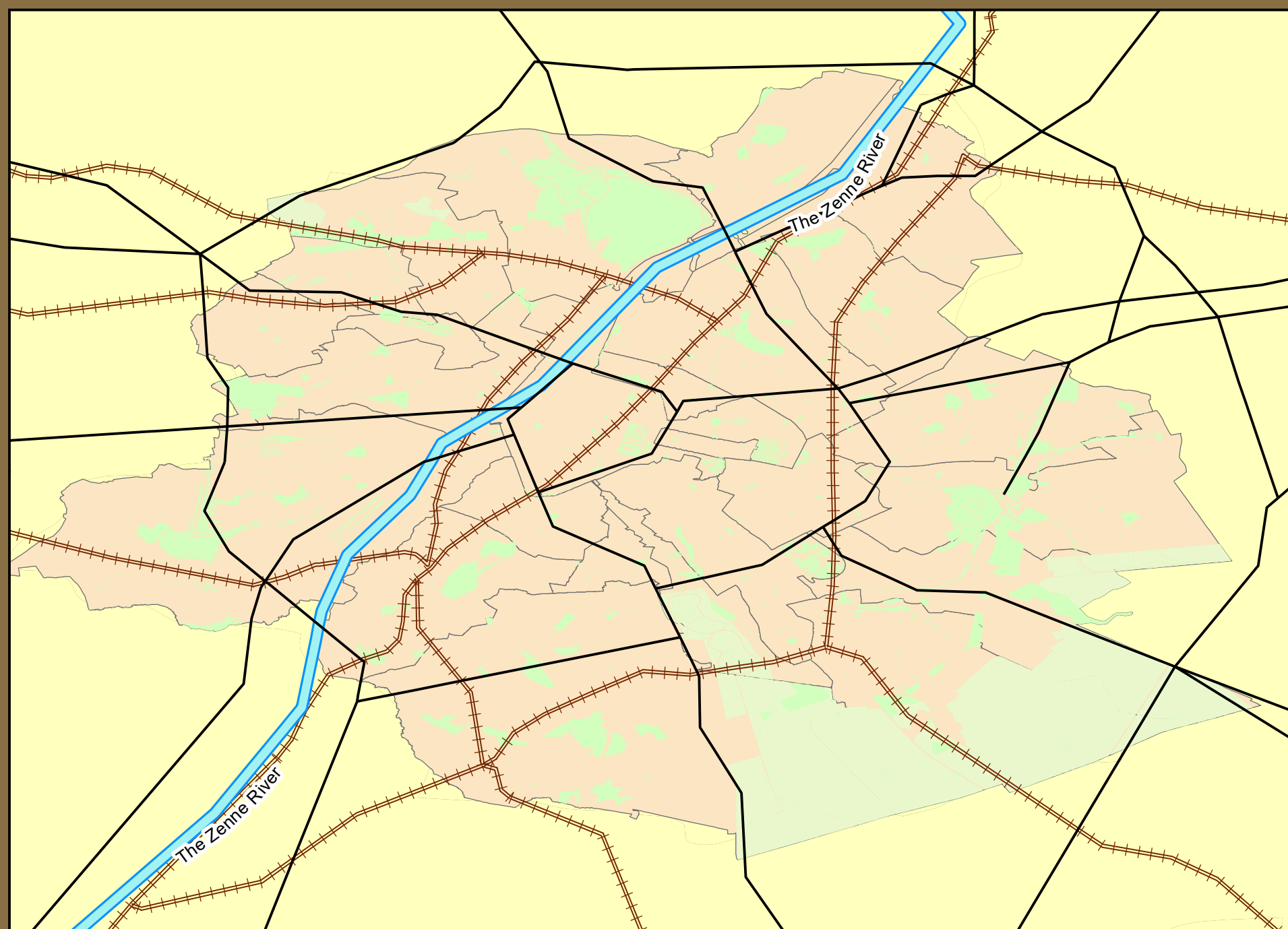




Brussels: The Capital of Europe

Brussels, the capital region of Belgium, consists of 19 municipal districts. It is a major hub for both Flemish (Dutch speaking) and Wallonian (French speaking) citizens, who are typically divided into the Northern and Southern poles of the nation and quite frequently at political and cultural odds.

It is poetic that the capital city of such a divided nation also serves as the primary federal location of the European Union, serving as the seat of the European Commission, Council of Europe, and the European Parliament.

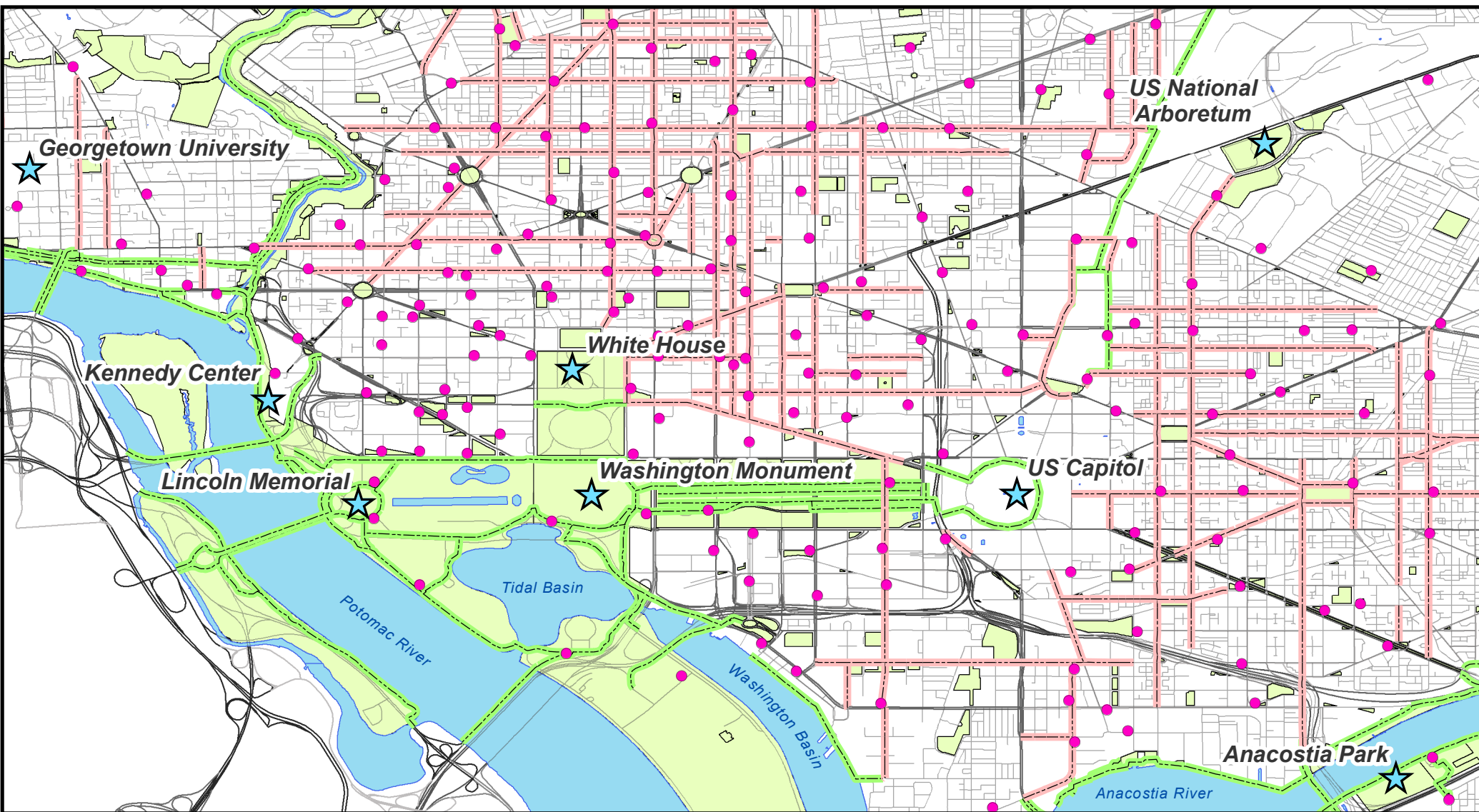
Ironically, Brussel's long history of hosting international institutions is due to lack of agreement between Europe's great powers rather than unionist sentiments. Belgium was considered a weak (and off-limits) central location within the European power block.

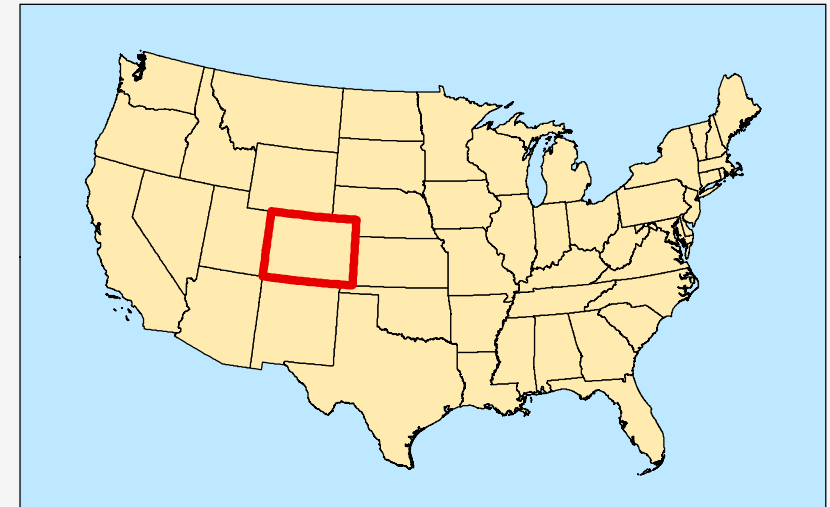

Boston's Colleges and Universities

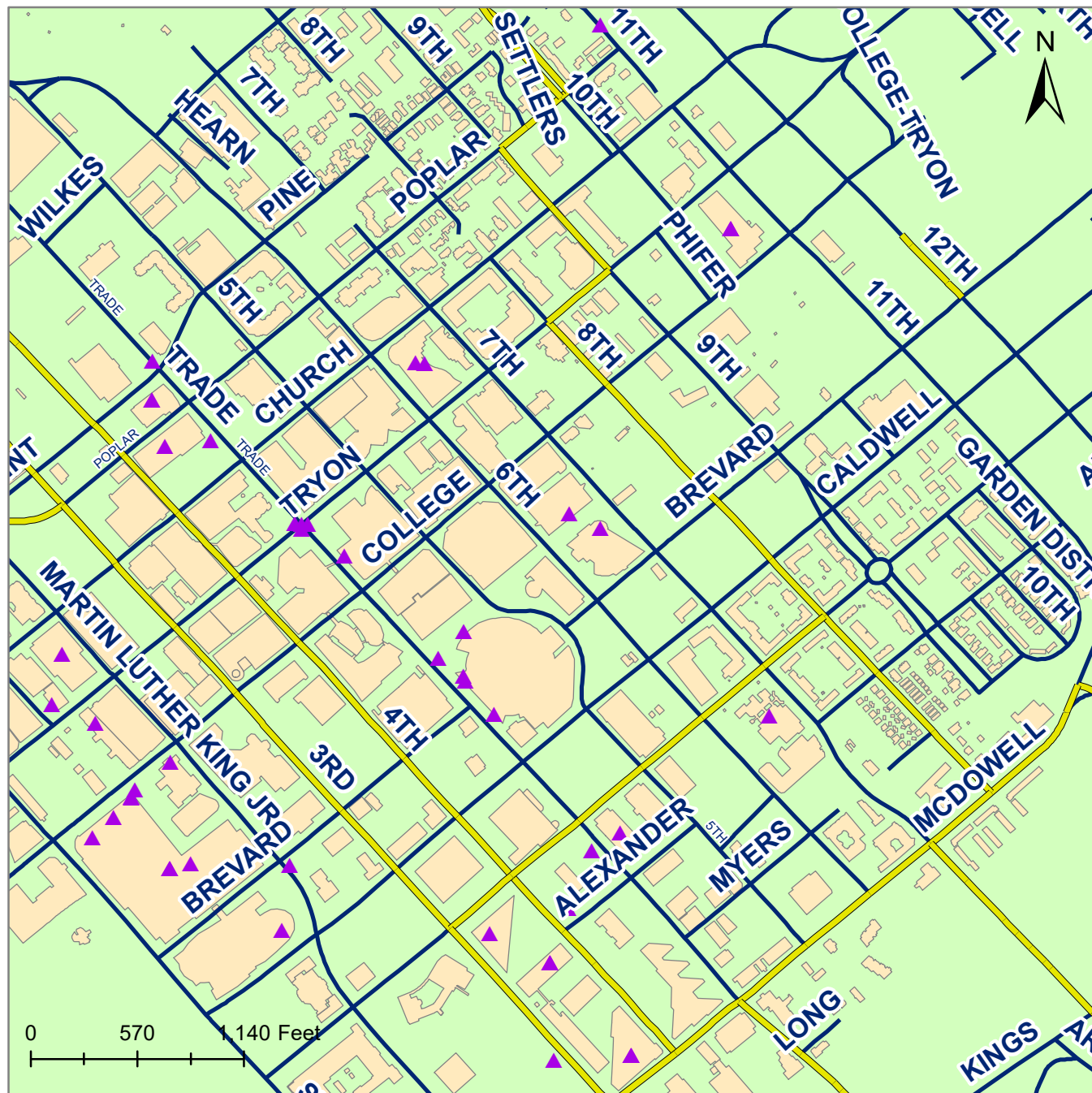

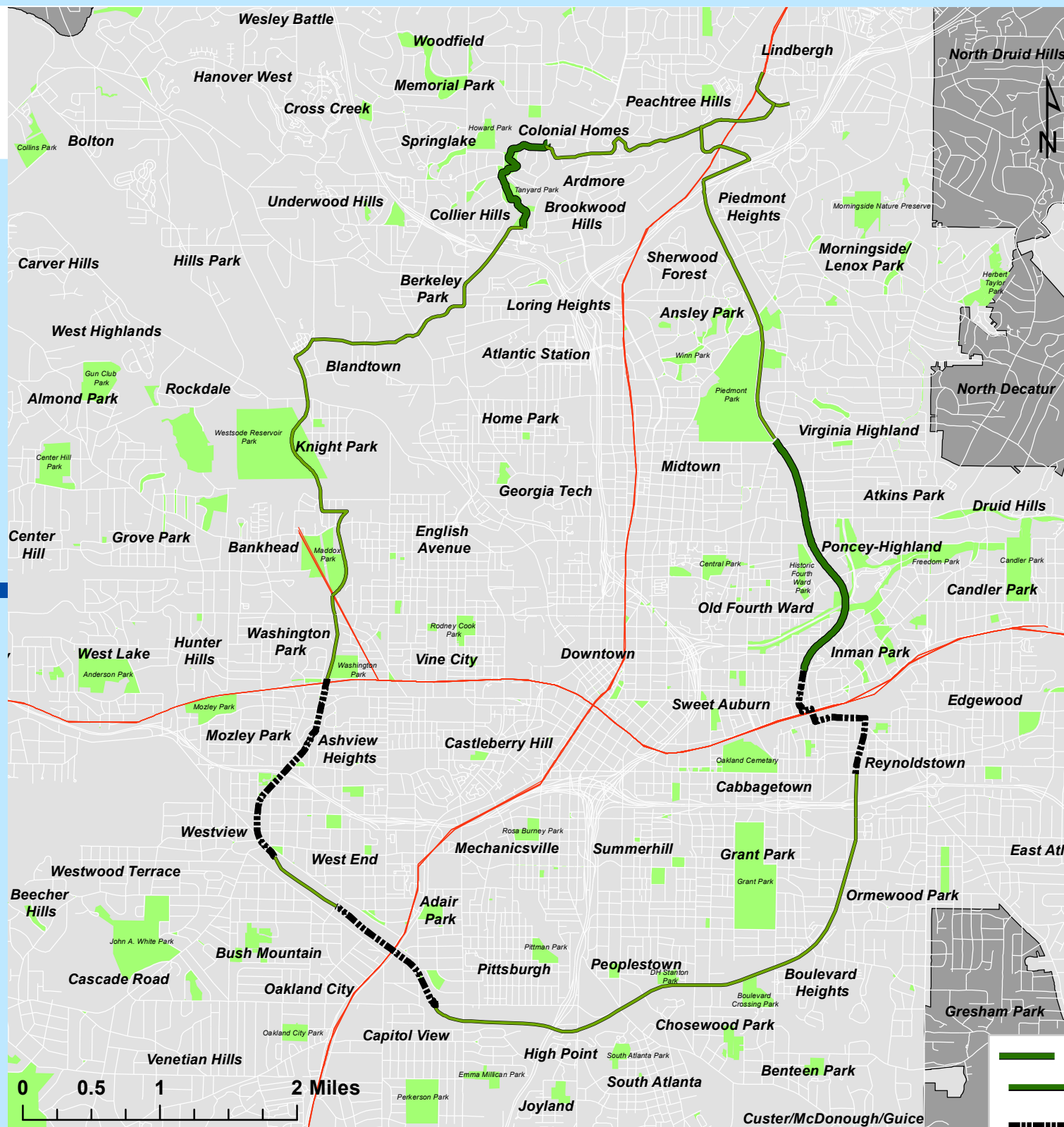

About the Project

The BeltLine is a former railway corridor around the core of Atlanta, GA, under development in stages as a multi-use trail. Some portions are already complete, while others are still in a rough state but hikeable. Using existing rail track easements, the BeltLine is designed to improve transportation, add green space, and promote redevelopment. There are longer-term visions for streetcar or light-rail lines along all or parts of the corridor.

National Parks in the Southeast of the United States



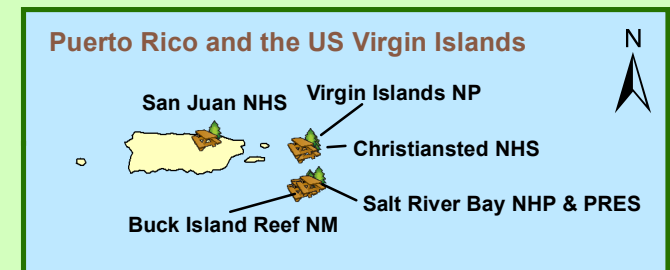
The first National Park (NP), Yellowstone, was founded in 1872. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson created the National Park Service which is under the authority of the Department of Interior. It is a federal agency responsible for all federally owned public parks, monuments, and memorials.



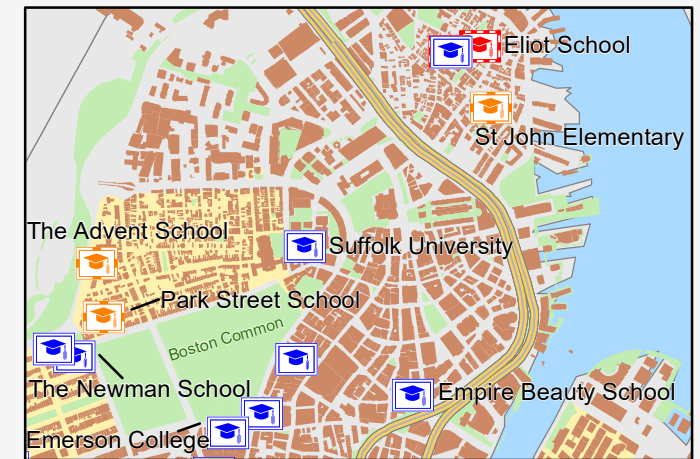
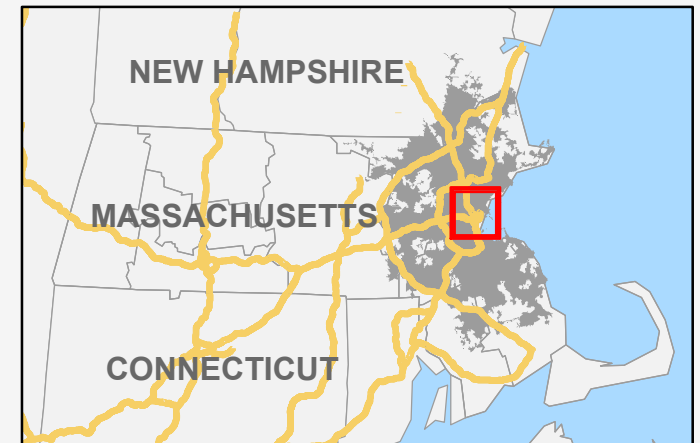
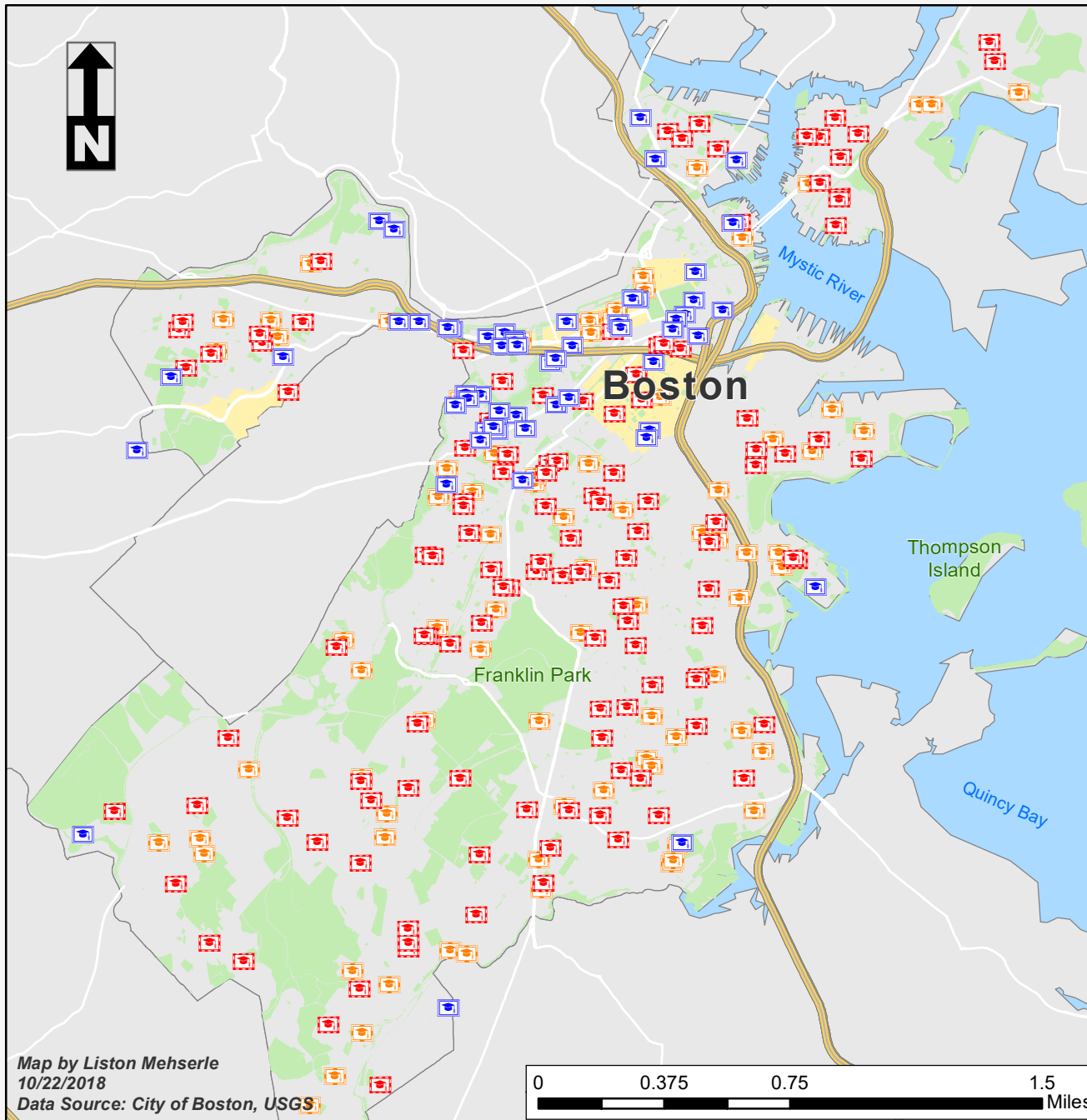

The Southeast region of the National Parks in the United States consists of 9 states (AL, FL, GA, KY, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN) and territories (Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands) and has 60 National Parks. The Great Smoky Mountains (GRSM) NP is located in the Great Smoky Mountains and the Blue Ridge Mountains. It is the most visited National Park in the US with over 11 million visitors annually. The 2 biggest visitor centers in the park are Sugarlands near Gatlinburg, TN and Oconaluftee near Cherokee, NC. There are 850 miles of trails and unpaved roads. Other activities to do in the park besides hiking include fishing, horseback riding, and biking.



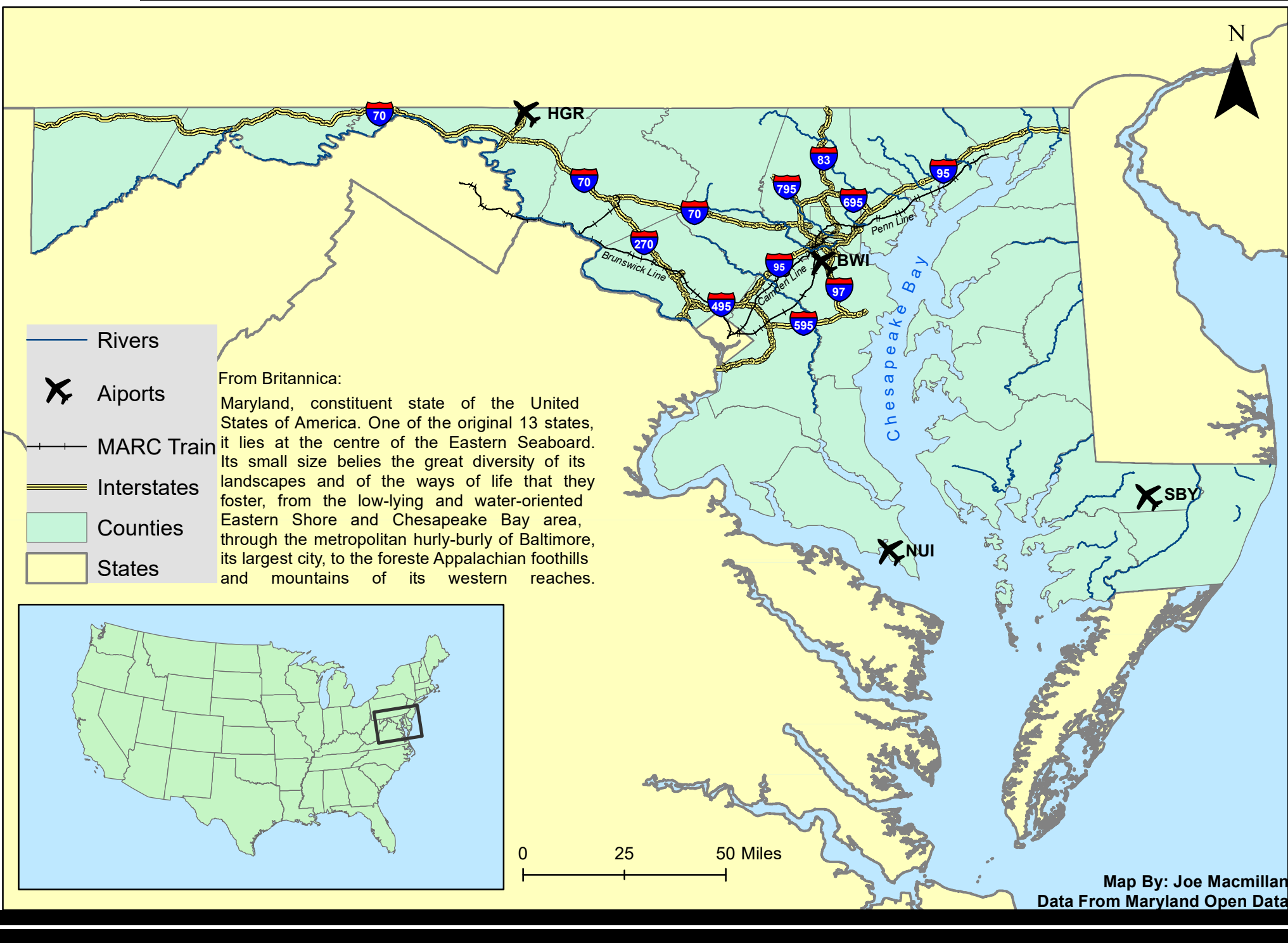
Education in Boston



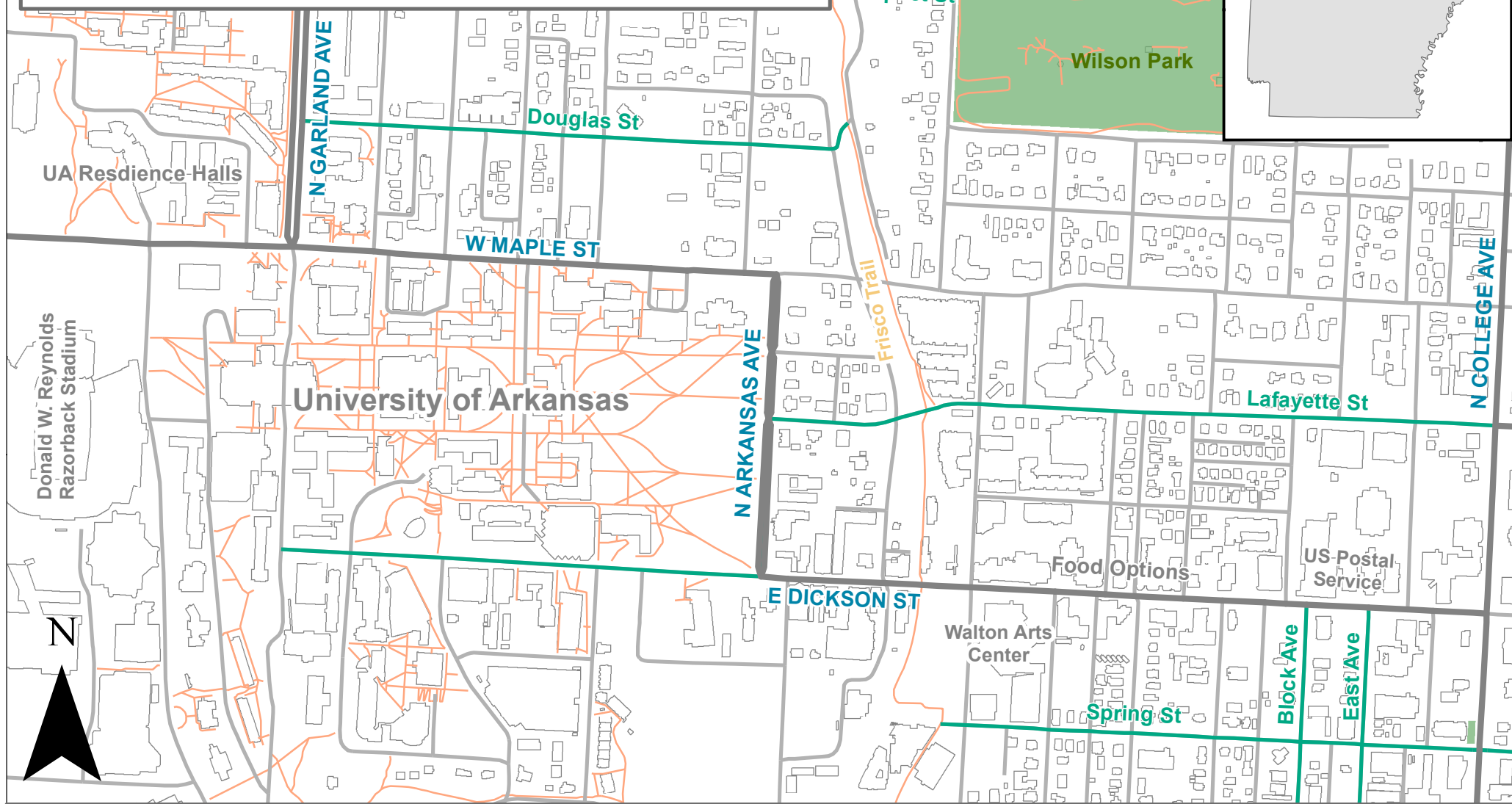

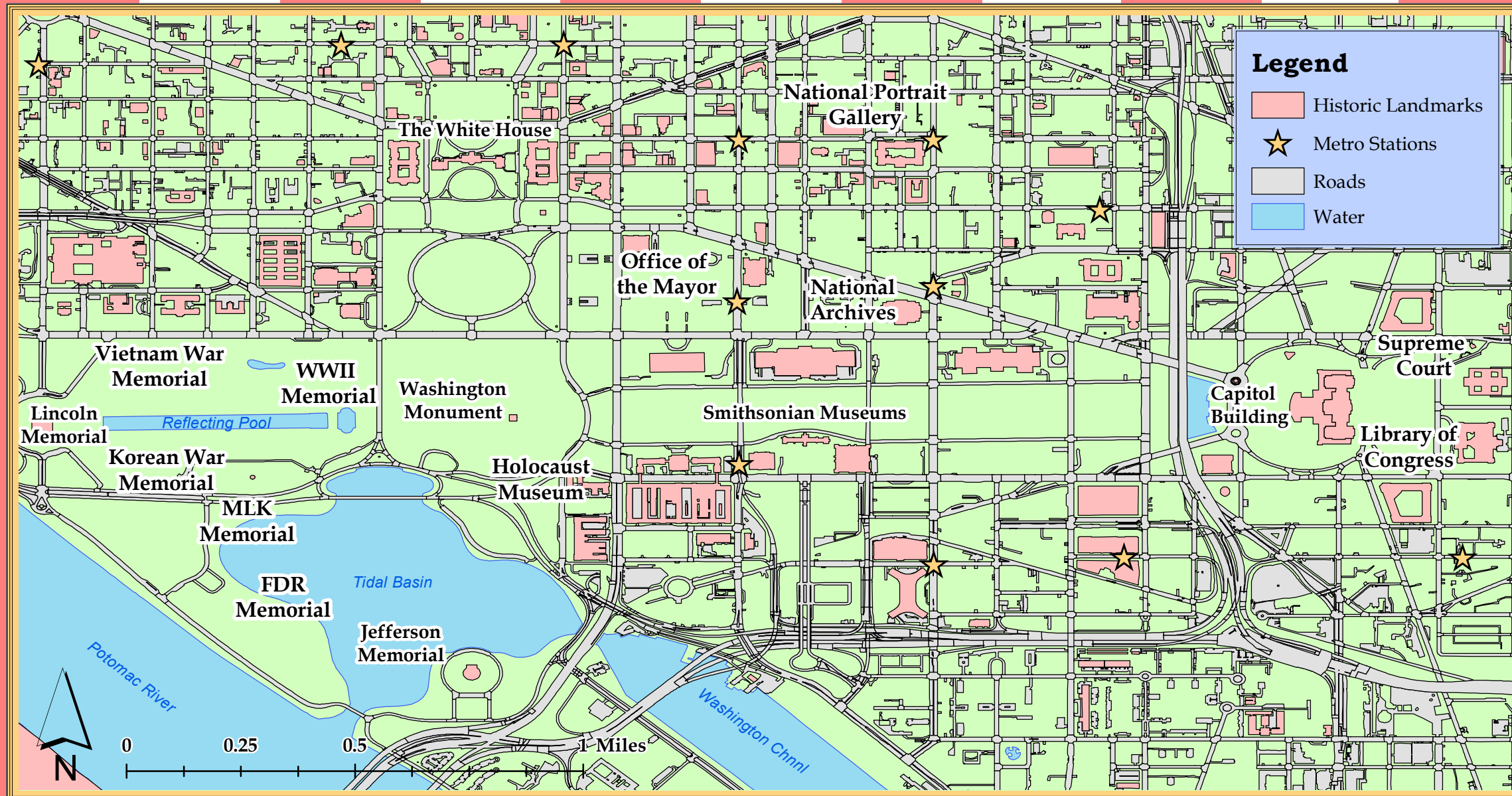

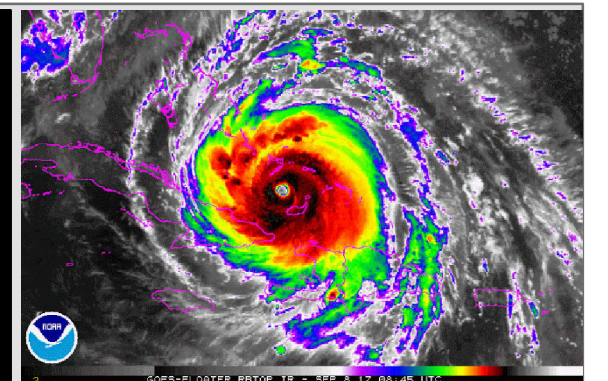
Washington State National Parks and Their Surrounding Ecoregions



For outdoors enthusiasts, Washington is an ideal state for exploration with its wide range of ecoregions, from the rainy Northwest Coast to the dry Columbia Plateau. An ecoregion is an area of land that reflects broad ecological patterns. Washington's western ecoregions are characterized by wetter climates and temperate rainforests. Moving eastward, the ecoregions become more desert-like as well as drier and hotter, with landscapes cut by rivers. Washington's diverse ecoregions are home to number of National Parks. Olympic National Park can be found on the Northwest Coast, with its alpine meadows and lush rainforests. Further inland, Nez Perce National Historical Park features a drier landscape with grasslands.

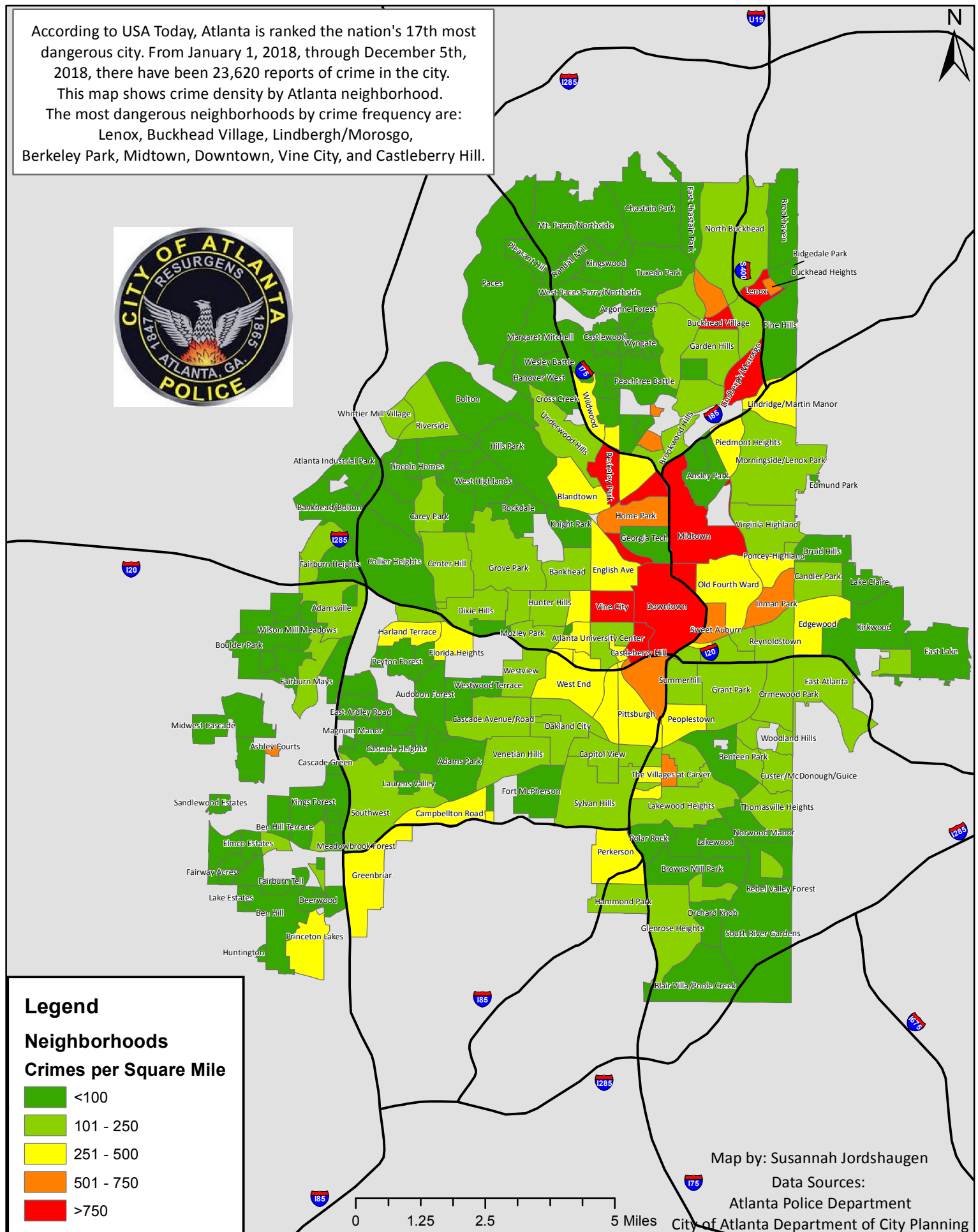

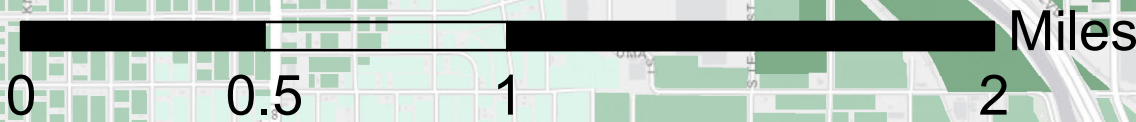
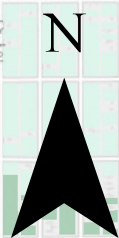


Going Car-Less in the City of Traffic: How Poverty Affects Mobility in Atlanta

Atlanta's reputation for being a car-dominated city precedes itself. Most residents cannot imagine life without a car. However, many large pockets of the city are made up of households without a single car, generally due to poverty. Owning a car is expensive, with one study showing that the state is one of the most expensive places in the US to own a car. The cost of insurance, repair and gasoline adds up to an average \$2,408 per Georgian (and this is not including purchase price for cars and other external costs such as parking). Although Atlanta offers some public transportation, this map shows huge pockets of the population that are stuck without a car and without a major mode of public transportation (MARTA train line). This limits their ability to find a job outside of their immediate community and make the money they need to get out of the cycle of poverty.

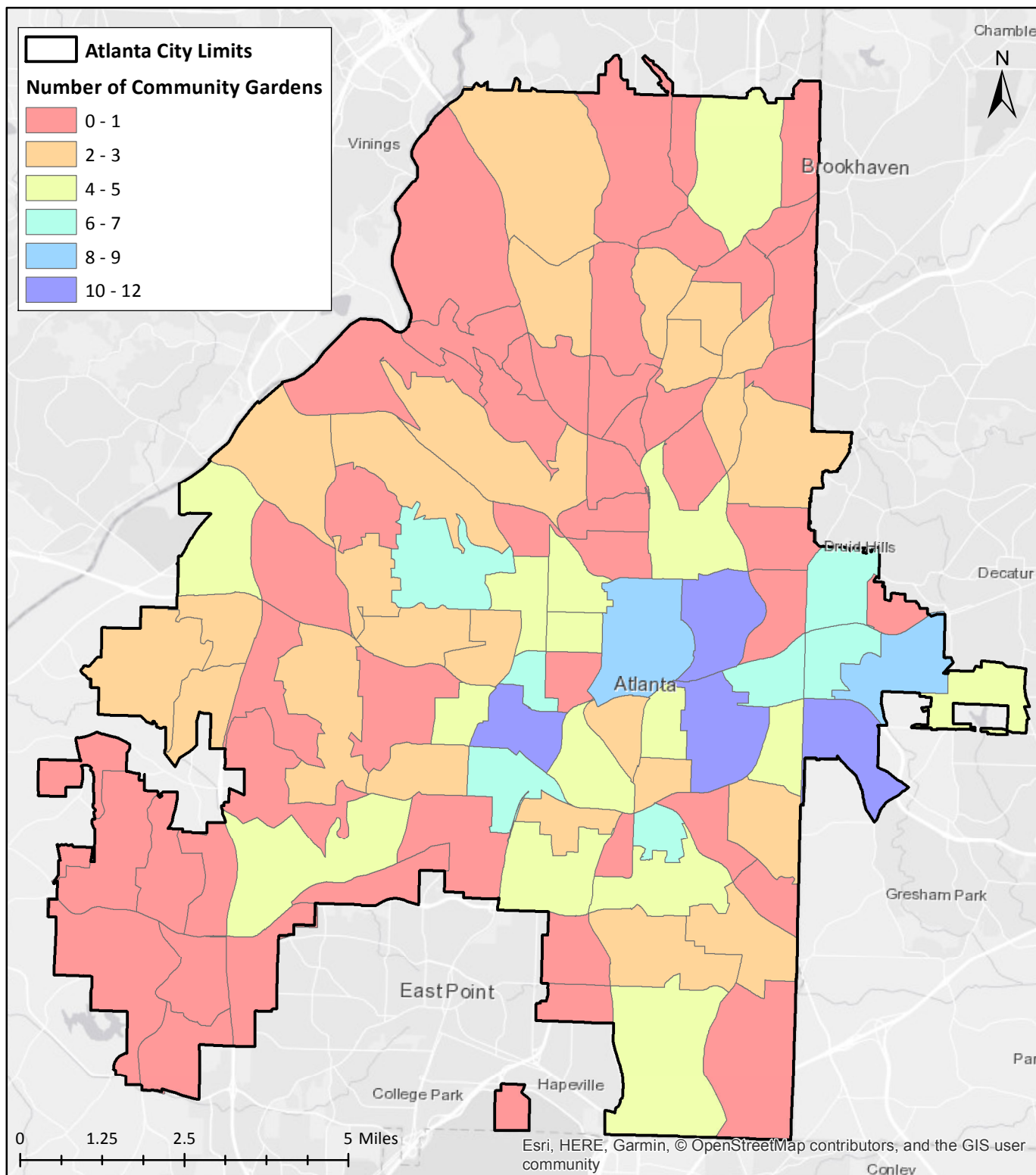

Bikeability score describes the convenience and ability for an area to support a lifestyle centered around cycling as a primary mode of transportation. Index takes multiple factors into account such as: proximity to downtown Denver, distance from business development, access to biking infrastructure, and quality of adjacent infrastructure. This index can be used to identify suitable areas to work or live for those interested in a cycling lifestyle.



Community Gardens in Atlanta Neighborhoods

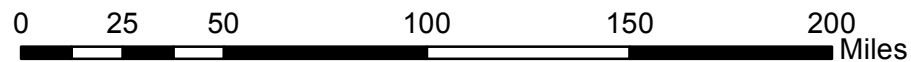

Map of Colorado: Major Cities and Roadways

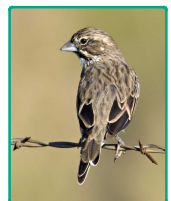

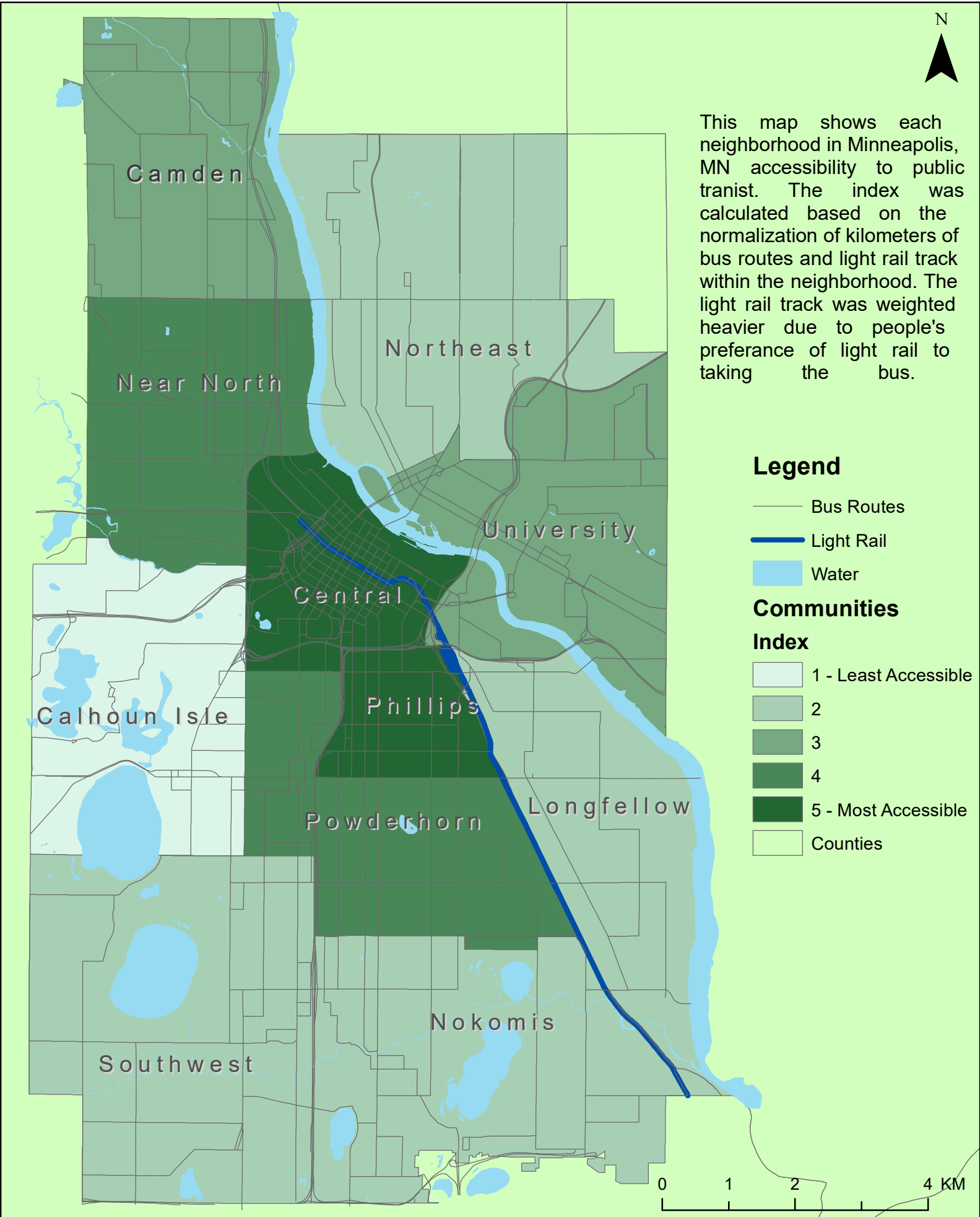

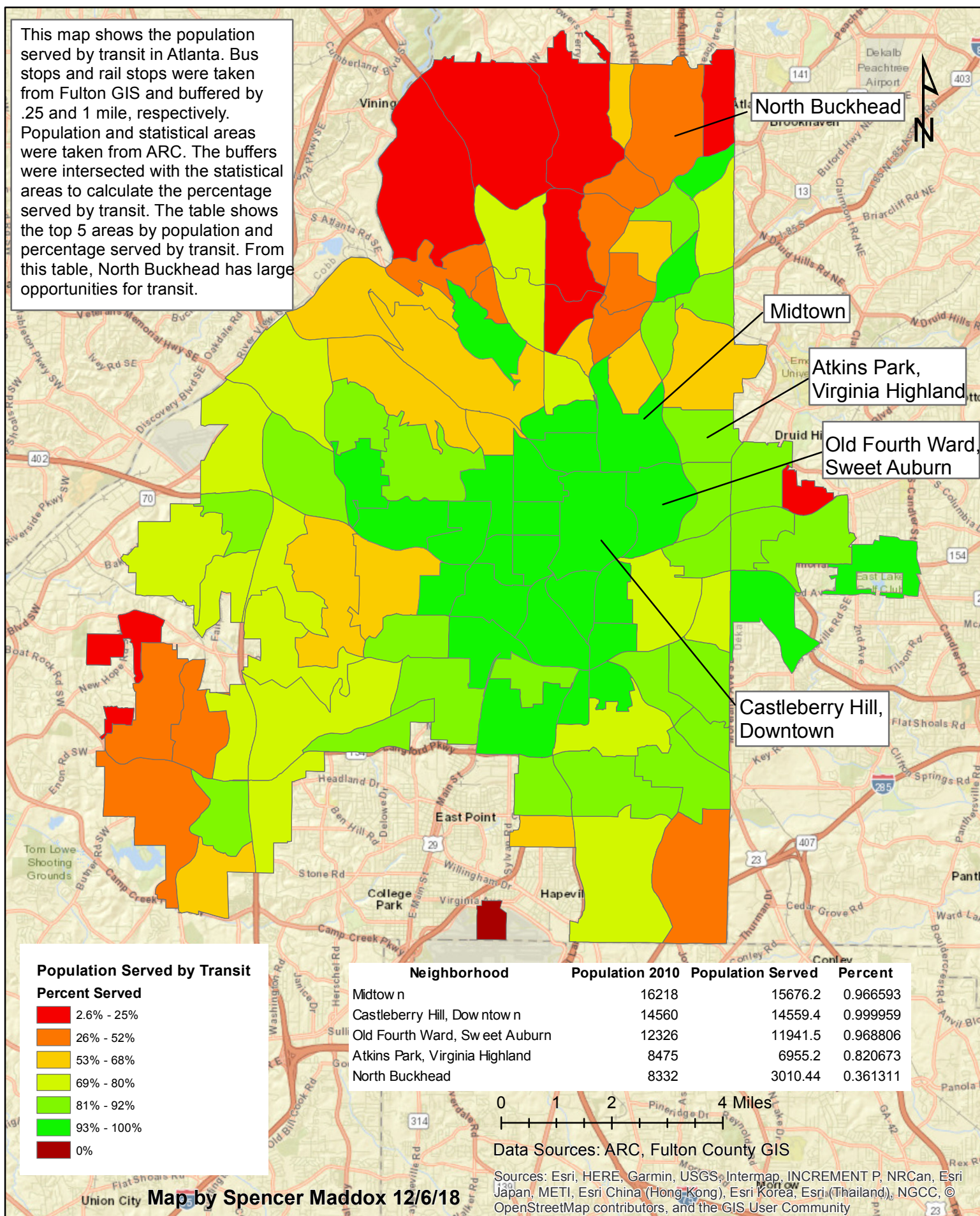


Index of Transit Accessibility in Minneapolis, MN

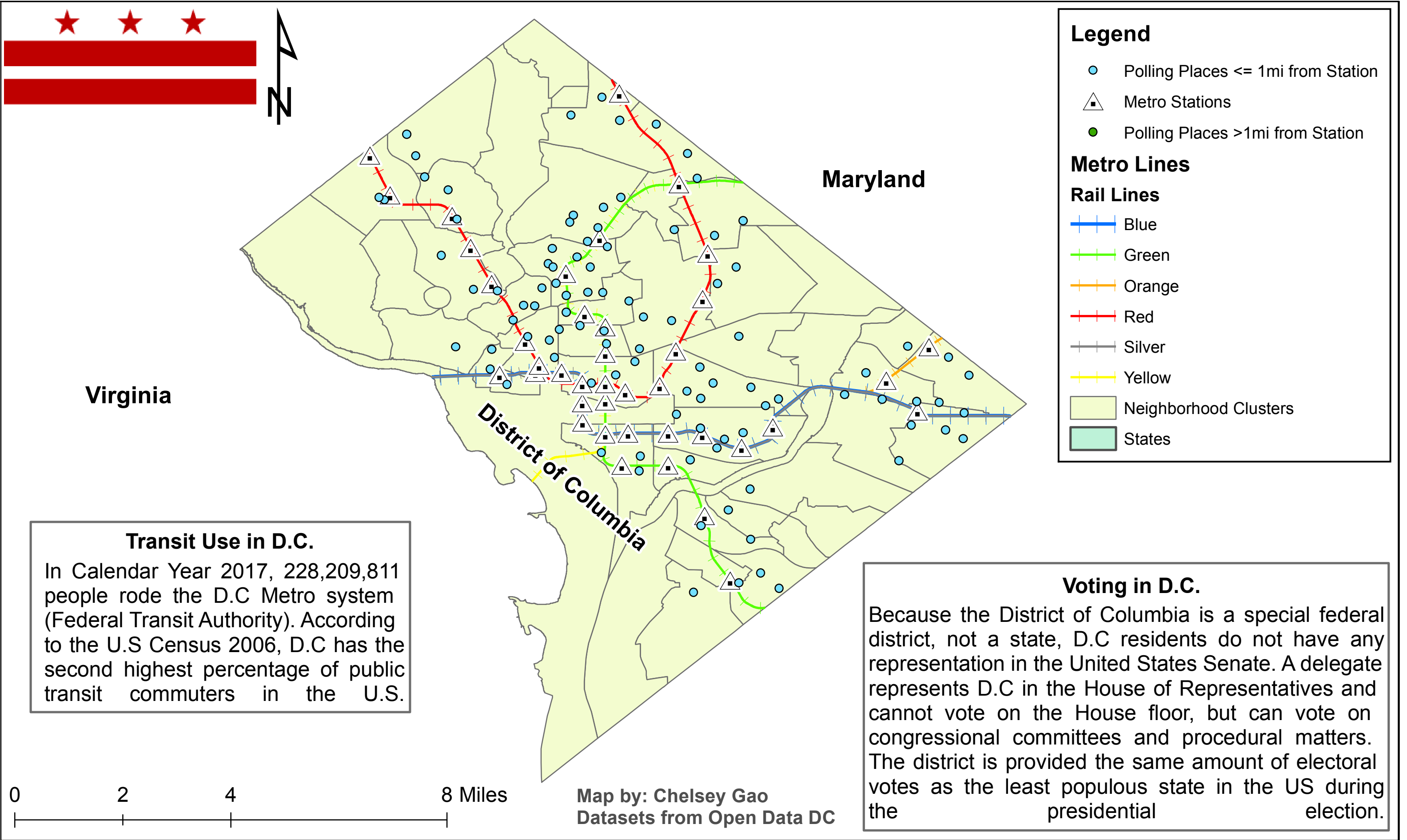

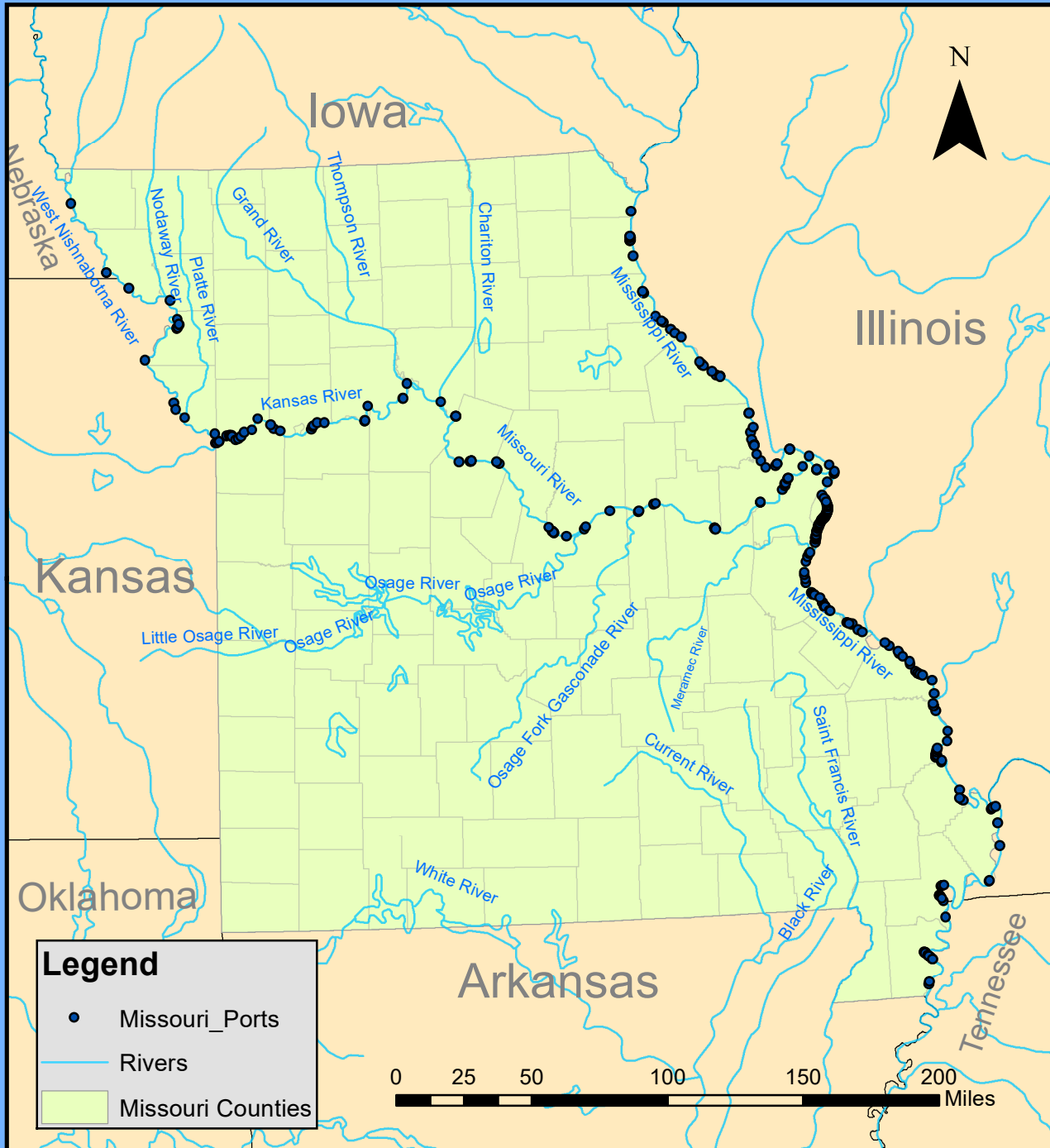
GDP by Provinces

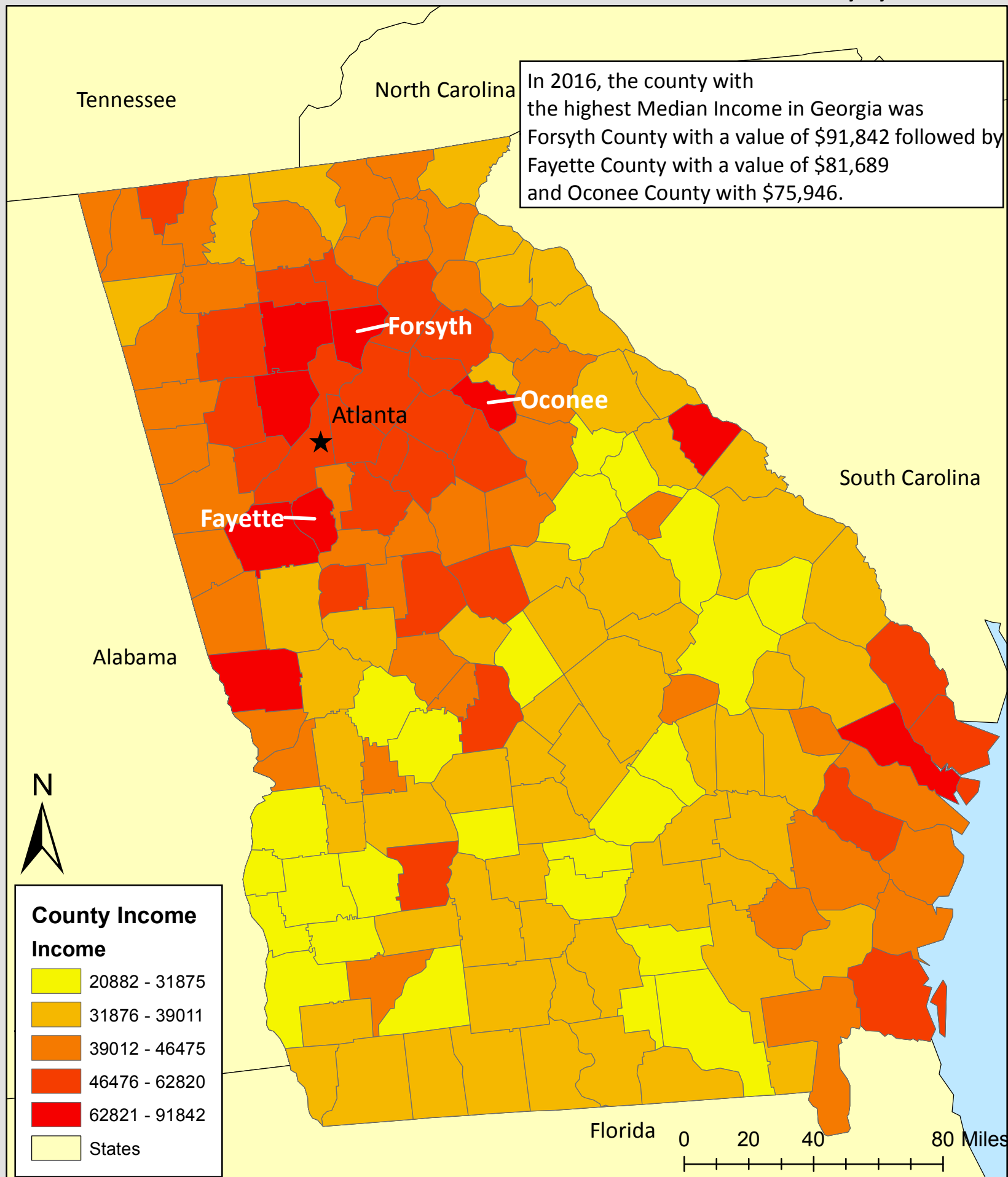

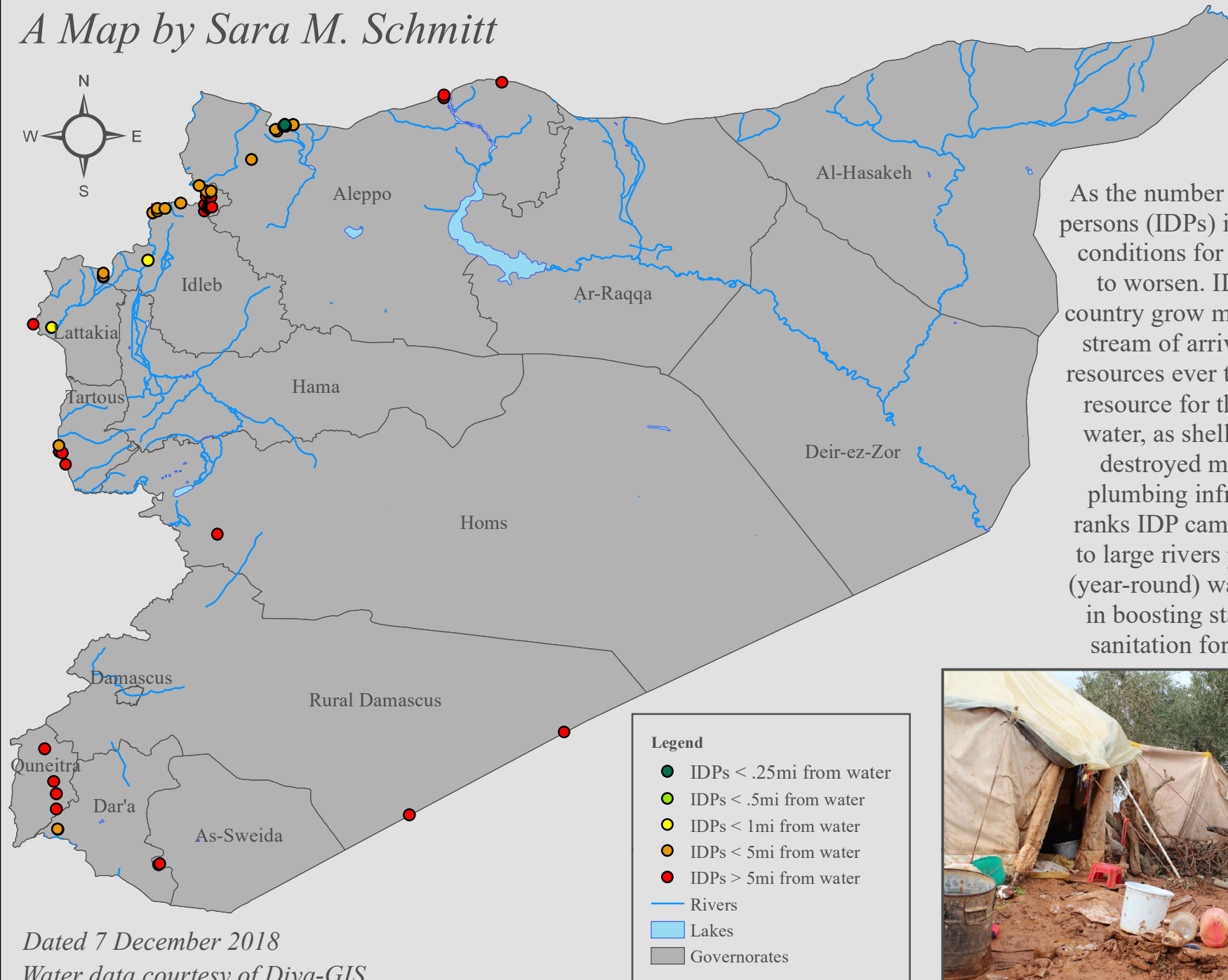

Water Access for Internally Displaced People in Syria

As the number of internally displaced persons (IDPs) in Syria nears 7 million, conditions for these people continue to worsen. IDP camps across the country grow more crowded with each stream of arrivals, spreading scarce resources ever thinner. One invaluable resource for these camps is potable water, as shelling and conflict have destroyed much of the country's plumbing infrastructure. This map ranks IDP camps based on proximity to large rivers providing a consistent (year-round) water supply, which aids in boosting standards of living and sanitation for all within the camp.



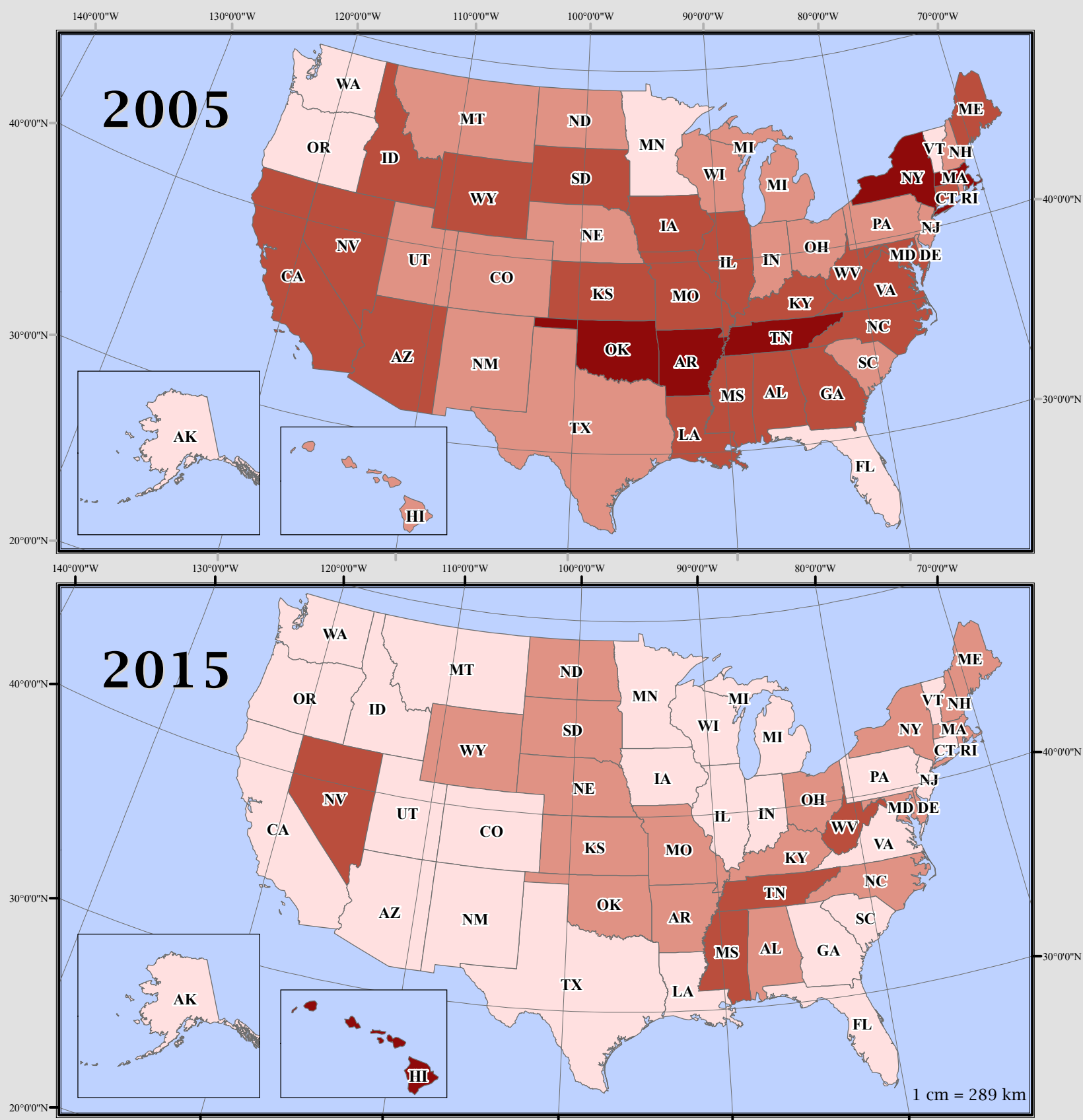

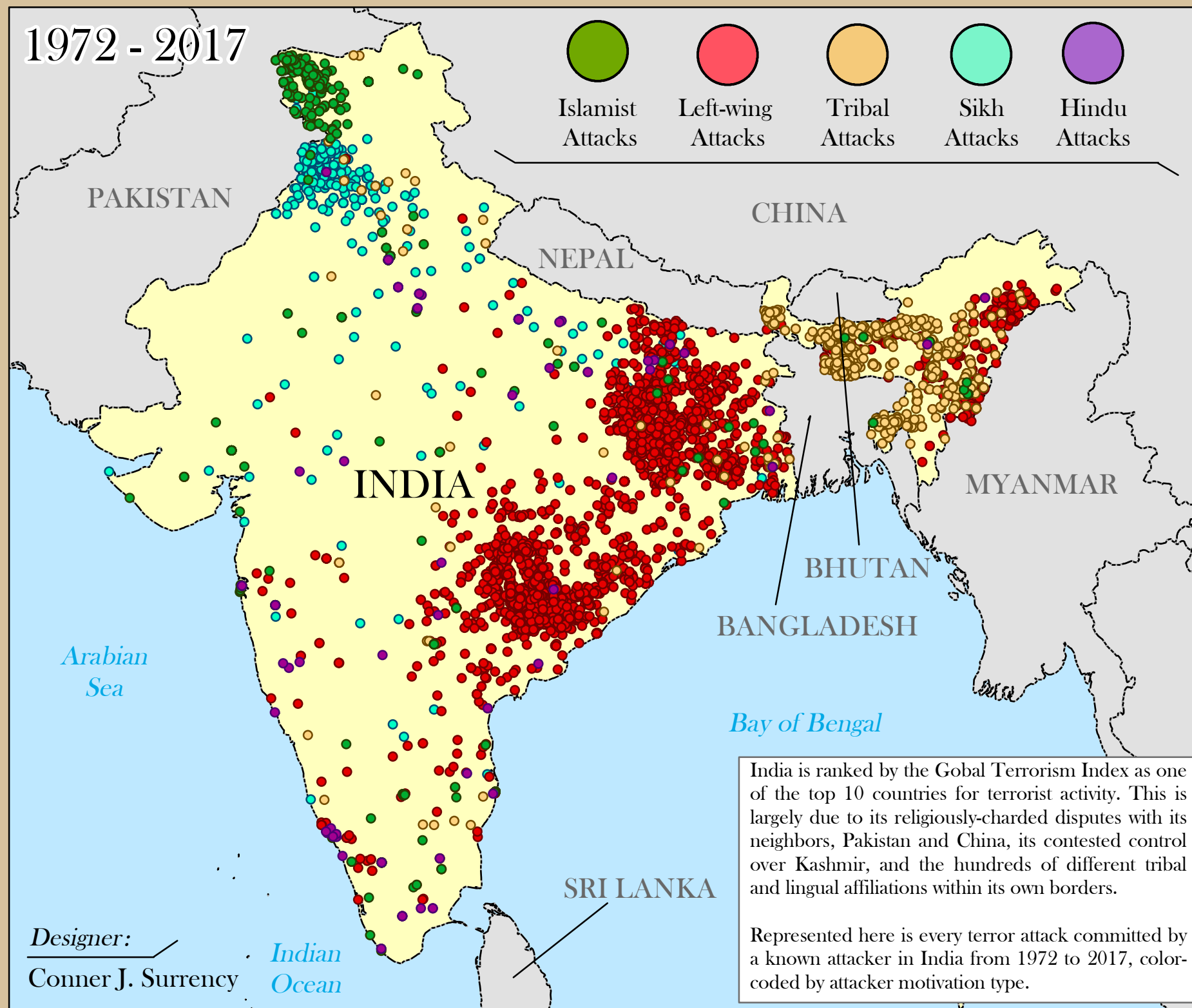

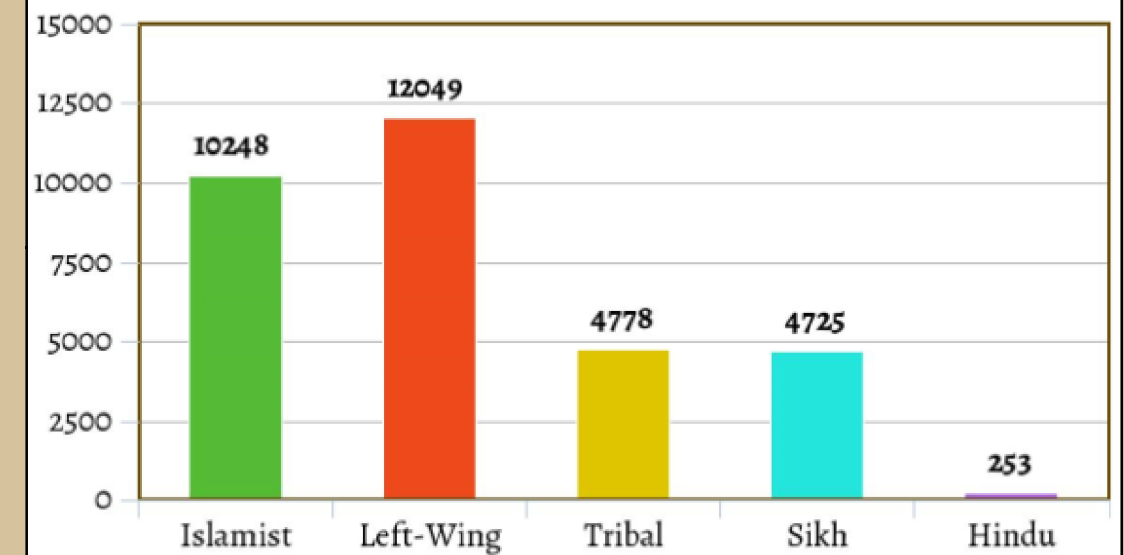

Represented here is every terror attack committed by a known attacker in India from 1972 to 2017, color-coded by attacker motivation type.

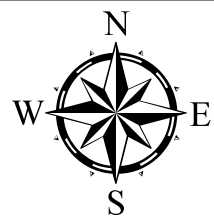
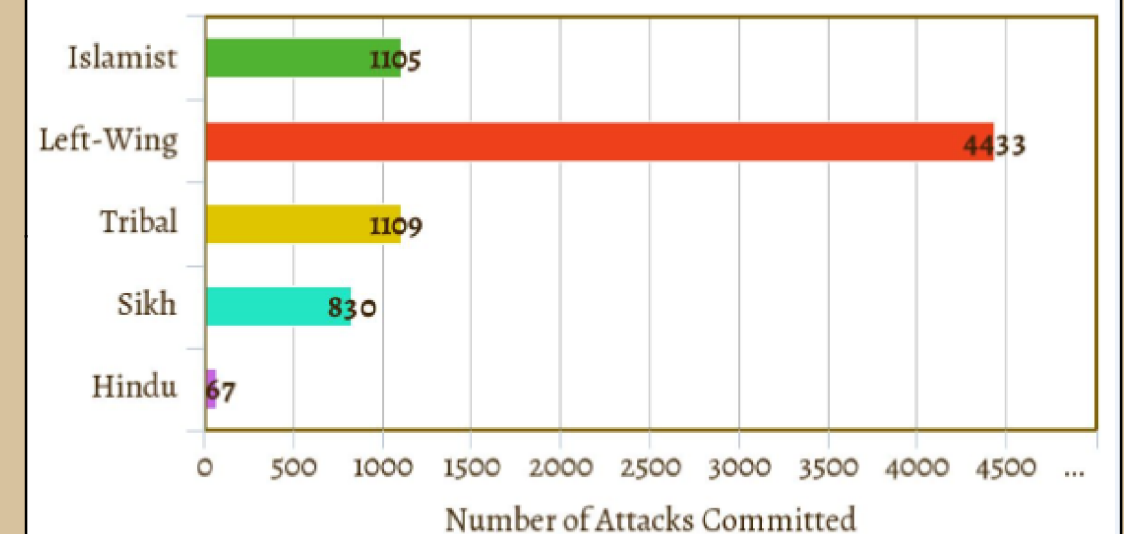

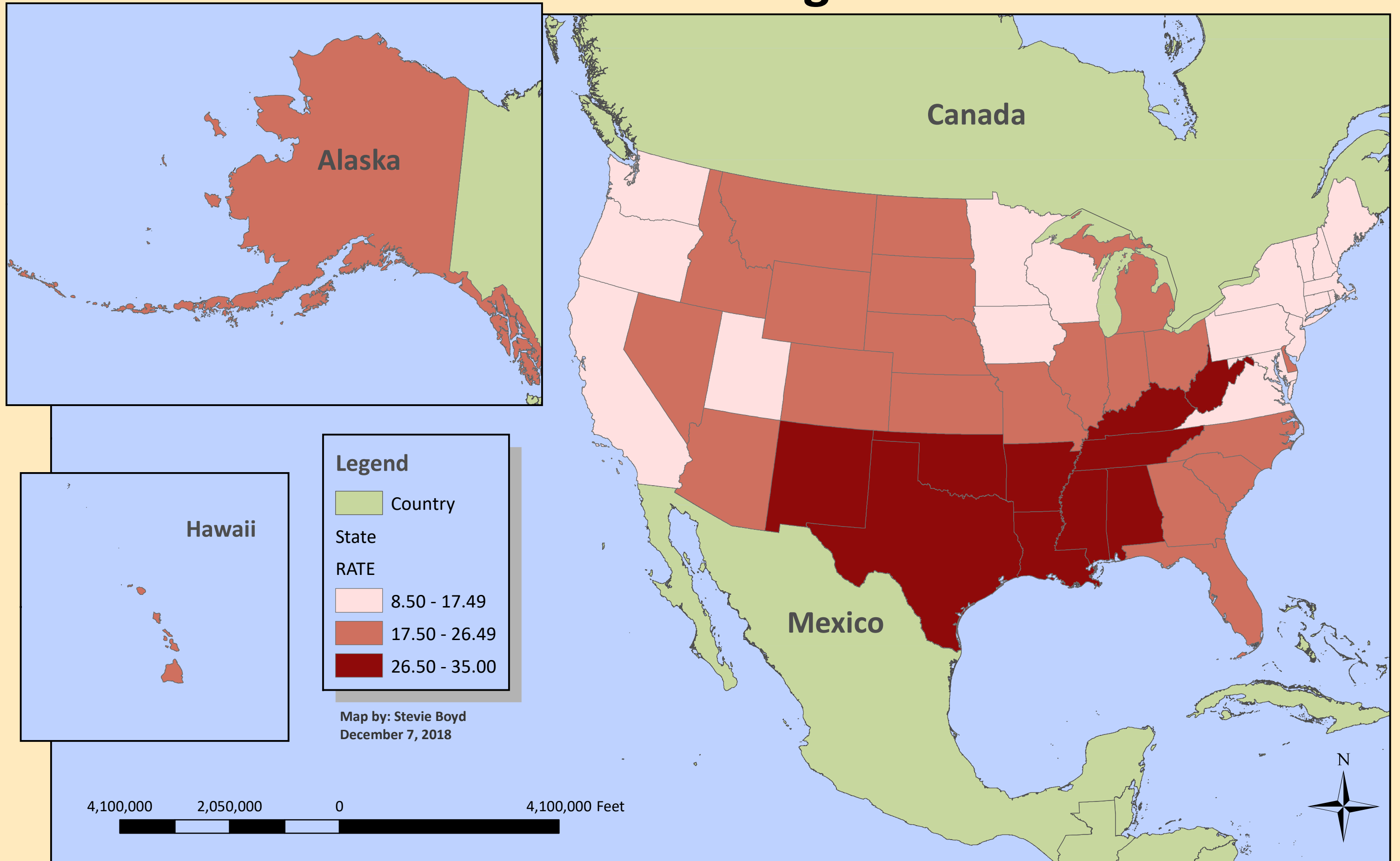

United States Teenage Birth Rate

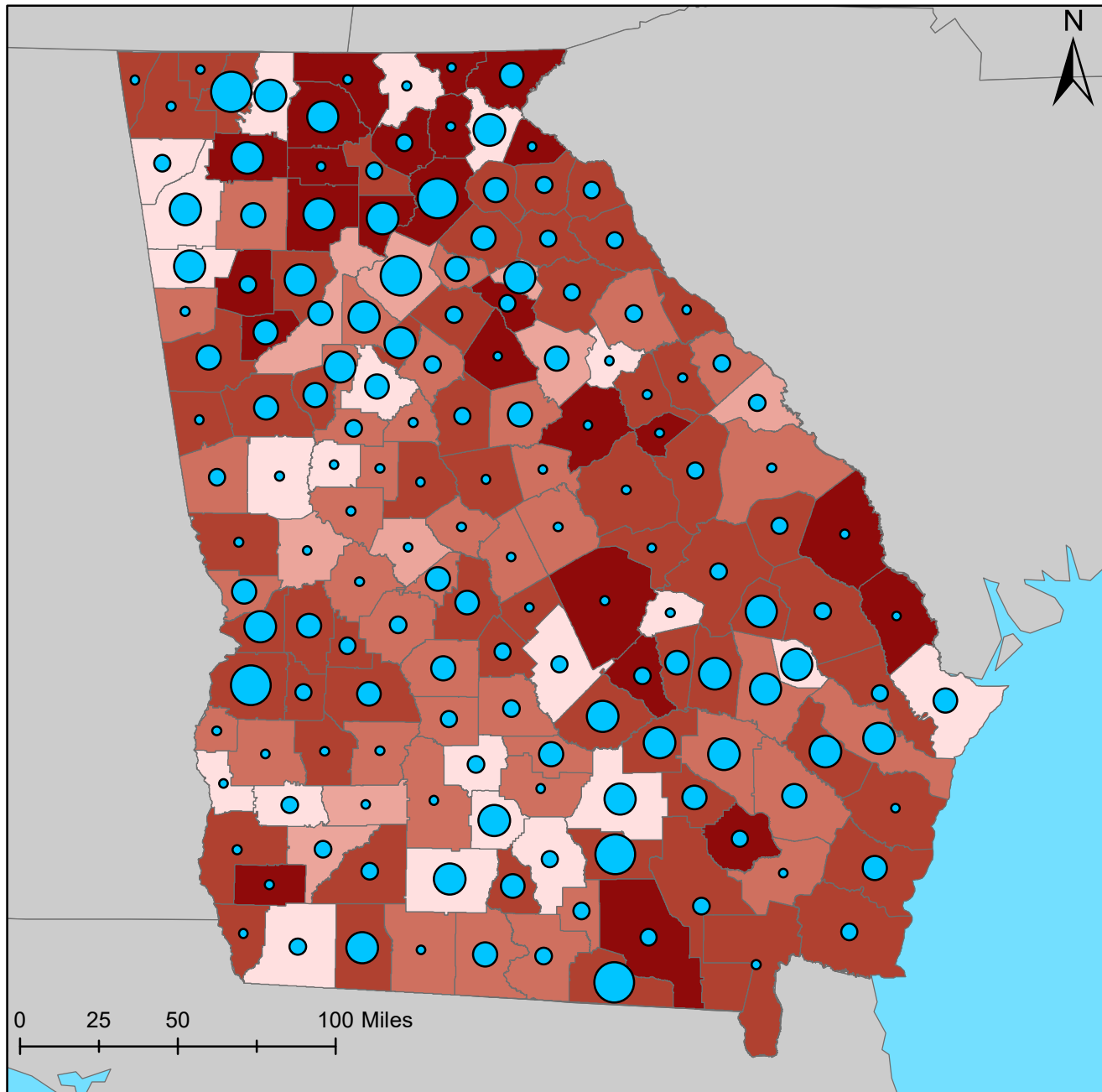

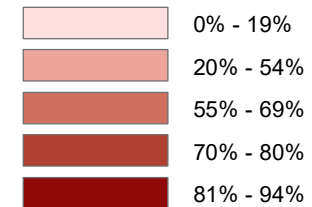

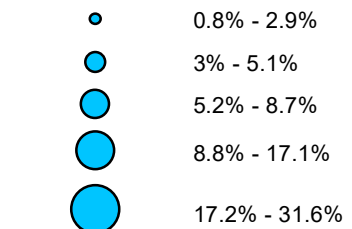

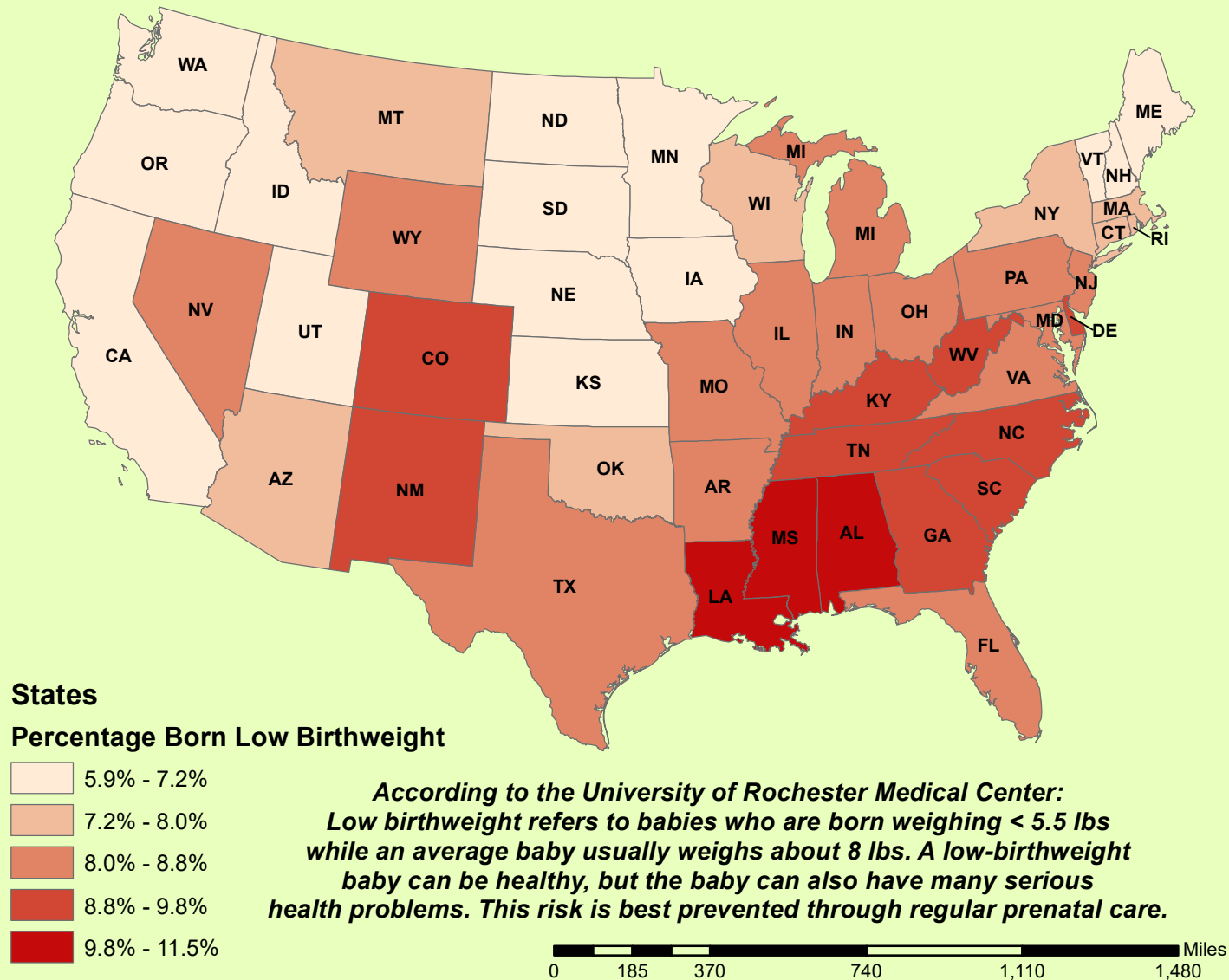
